

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FLINT

ORDINANCE NO. 081919A

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION NO. 11.2-6 AND SECTION NO. 11.2-7 OF CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FLINT CODE ORDINANCES WHICH ARTICLE CONCERNS THE USE OF FIREWORKS AND THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATING THE ORDINANCE.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FLINT ORDAINS:

SECTION 1.

Section 11.2-6 of the Charter Township of Flint Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11.2-6 - Prohibition

No person shall use consumer fireworks in the township other than on the following days after 11 a. m.:

- (a) December 31 until 1 a.m. on January 1.
- (b) The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.
- (c) June 29 to July 4 until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.
- (d) July 5, if that date is a Friday or Saturday, until 11:45 p.m.
- (e) The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.

SECTION 2

A person shall not ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks on public property, school property, church property, or the property of another person without that organization's or person's express permission to use those fireworks on those premises. A person who violates this section is responsible for a civil infraction and subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00.

SECTION 3

Section 11.2-7 of the Charter Township of Flint Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11.2-7 – Penalty

A person who violates section 1 of this ordinance shall be responsible for a civil infraction and subject to a fine of \$1,000 for each violation. \$500.00 of each fine collected under this ordinance shall be remitted to the township police department.

SECTION 4

The remainder of Chapter 11, Article 2 remains unchanged.
