CODE OF CONDUCT

Trailway Rules

- Only Non-Motorized Vehicles Allowed
- Electric Wheelchairs are Permitted
- Dogs Must be Under Control on a 6' Leash and Droppings Removed.
- No Smoking
- Alcoholic Beverages Are Not Permitted
- No Trespassing on Private Property
- No Camping, Open Fires, Hunting or Littering
- No Littering Please Use Trash Bins

Trail Way Etiquette

- KEEP RIGHT**
Except when passing and turning.
- SIGNAL OTHERS**
Alert when passing by voice or bell.
- YIELD**
Cyclists must yield to all others.
- RIDE APPROPRIATELY**
Except when passing and turning.
- BE AWARE**
Violation of Township ordinances may be punishable by a \$500 fine or jail or both.
