Our Creation

- March 5, 2018 The Flint Township Board created the Flint Township DDA, Bristol Road CIA and the Beecher Road CIA Authorities and appointed the Authority Boards.
- March 15, 2018

The Flint Township DDA Board, Bristol Road CIA Board and the Beecher Road CIA Board met for the first time. Their meetings were conducted simultaneously. They elected officers, adopted by-laws and started creating the Development and Tax Increment Financing Plans for each Authority.

• March 22, 2018

The Flint Township DDA Board and the Bristol Road CIA Board met together, held their Public Hearings, and approved their individual Development and Tax Increment Financing Plans.

• March 28, 2018

The Beecher Road CIA Board held their Public Hearing and approved their individual Development and Tax Increment Financing Plan.

• April 11, 2018

The Flint Township DDA approved the 2018 Budget and the Loan Agreement with the Charter Township of Flint.

- April 12, 2018
 The Bristol Road CIA Board and the Beecher Road CIA Board approved their individual 2018 Budgets and the Loan Agreements with the Charter Township of Flint.
- May 2, 2018

The Development Plans and Tax Increment Financing Plans for each Authority were presented to and adopted by the Township Board of Trustees. The Township Board of Trustees approved each Authority 2018 Budget and the

individual loan agreements providing the funds needed to start projects immediately.
